

Instructions for setting IP manually

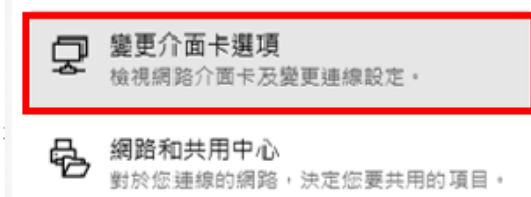
- Note 1: Due to the different settings in each building of faculty dormitory, the website of the Computer and Network Center has the setting values for each building. Please refer to the settings on the webpage.
- Note 2: There is no need to set the IP manually (such as: Tzu-Chiang dormitory) if the dormitory is in DHCP mode.
- Note 3: Please set the IP and other values by yourself if you want to use a Wi-Fi router. The center will not assist in setting, please refer to the user manual of the Wi-Fi router to set up by yourself.

Windows :

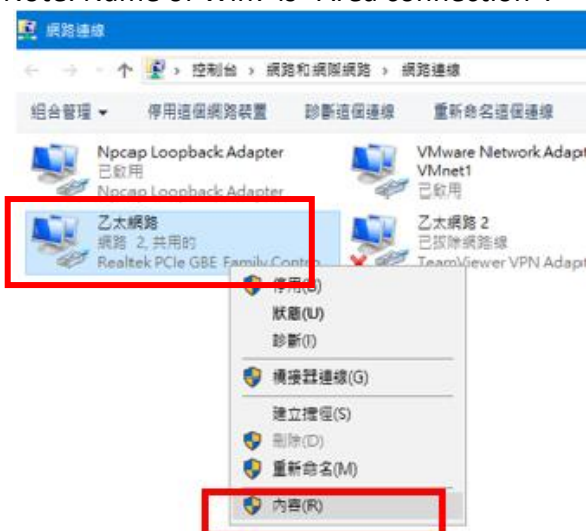
1. Right click the network icon in the lower right corner of the computer, and select "Open Network & Internet Settings".



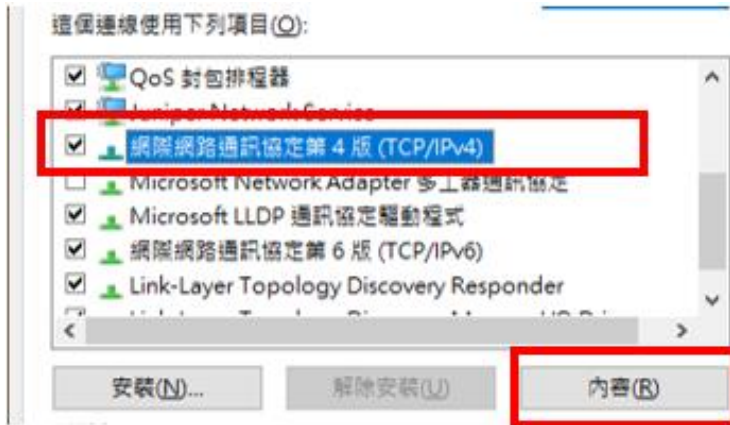
2. Click "Change adapter options".



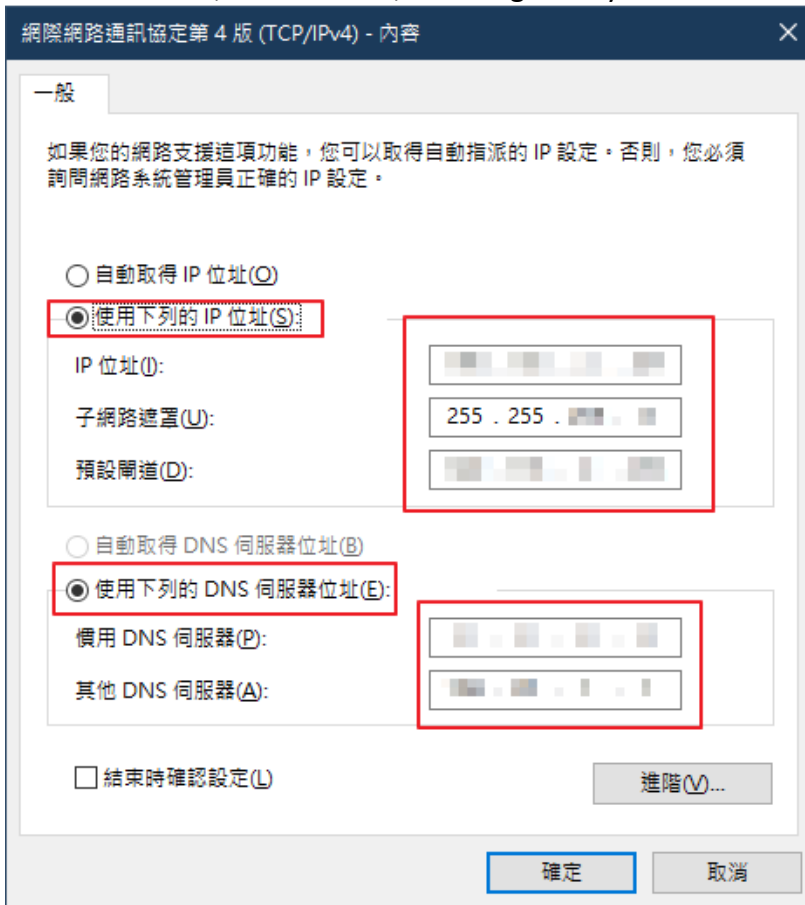
3. The network cards in the computer will be listed, right click "Ethernet" and select "Properties".
Note: Name of Win7 is "Area connection".



- 4、 Find "**Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IP)**", and then click "**Properties**".

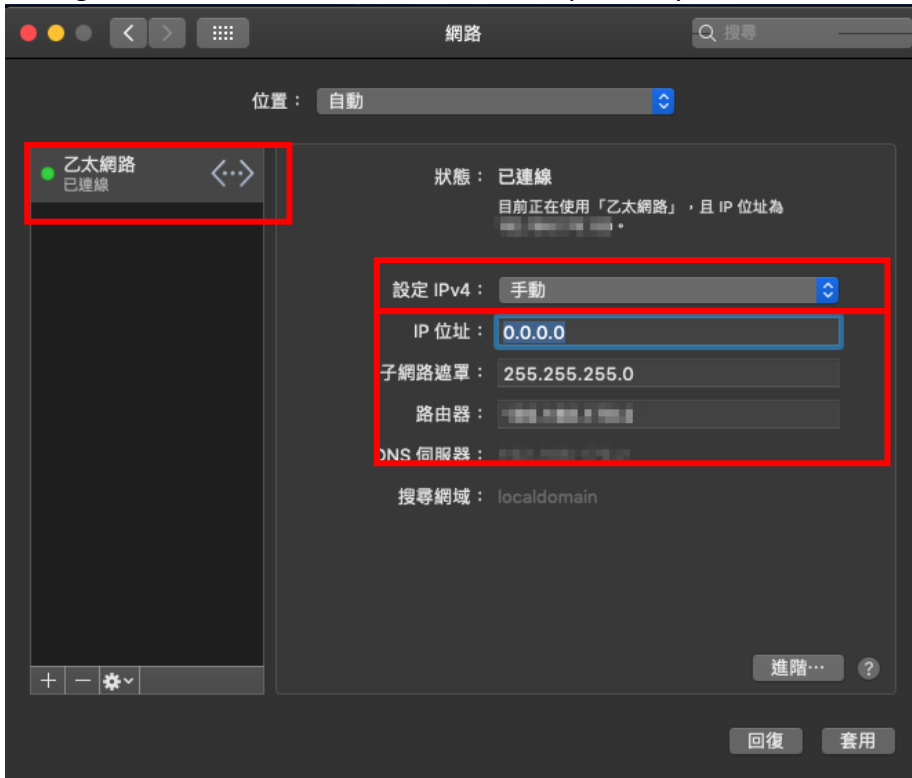


- 5、 Please set IP, subnet mask, default gateway and DNS in order.



Mac :

Select "Ethernet" on the left in the "System Preferences"\' "Network", and select "Manual" for "Set IP" on the right. Then fill in the relevant values sequentially.



Click "Advanced"\' "DNS", and then click the "+" sign to set.
